### 2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

## 5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

<b>Extinguishing media:</b>	Extinguishing substances are carbon dioxide, foam or chemical powder. For product loss or leakage that has not caught fire, water spray can be used to disperse flammable vapours and protect those trying to stem the leak. <b>Do not use jets of water.</b> Water is not effective for putting out fires but can be used to cool containers exposed to flames to prevent explosions.
<b>Special hazards:</b>	Excess pressure may form in containers exposed to fire at a risk of explosion. <b>Do not breathe combustion products.</b>

<b>Environmental precautions:</b>	<b>The product must not penetrate into the sewer system or come into contact with surface water or ground water.</b>
<b>Containment and clean up:</b>	Collect the leaked product into a suitable container. Evaluate the compatibility of the container to be used, by checking section 10. Absorb the remainder with inert absorbent material. Make sure the leakage site is well aired. Check incompatibility for container material in section 7. Contaminated material should be disposed of in compliance with the provisions set forth in point 13.

## 7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

<b>Precautions for safe handling:</b>	<b>Keep away from heat, sparks and naked flames;</b> do not smoke or use matches or lighters. Without adequate ventilation, vapours may accumulate at ground level and, if ignited, catch fire even at a distance, with the danger of backfire. <b>Avoid bunching of electrostatic charges. Do not eat, drink or smoke during use.</b> Remove any contaminated clothes and personal protective equipment before entering places in which people eat. Avoid leakage of the product into the environment.
<b>Conditions for safe storage:</b>	Store only in the original container. Store in a well ventilated place, keep far away from sources of heat, naked flames and sparks and other sources of ignition. Keep containers away from any incompatible materials, see section 10 for details.
